Join our 1st Day: SEA Breakfast Club. *No RSVP required.*

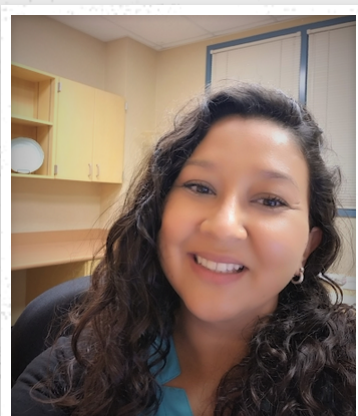
There will be signs on the first day to guide you to the Library where you will meet your SEA ambassador for the morning and meet a few new SEA students.
