

Science & Engineering Fair Time Management Timeline

- 1.** **Week of Sept. 6-12**

 - Class Meetings with Academic Research presentation
 - Decide which research option you're interested in
 - Read through science categories & subcategories
 - Make a list of categories you're interested in
- 2.** **Week of Sept. 13-19**

 - Search your categories of interest (start with general Google searches)
 - Brainstorm a list of topics from those categories
 - Choosing a topic is the hardest part - stick with ones that interest you!
- 3.** **Week of Sept. 20-26**

 - RESEARCH!
 - As you research, your topic may change or adjust - that's okay!
 - Keep a list of articles and websites - you'll need these for your Bibliography
- 4.** **Week of Sept. 27- Oct. 3**

 - Keep researching
 - Start to develop your plan and start documentation in Scienteer
 - Type out a detailed list of materials (incl. sizes, amounts, etc.)

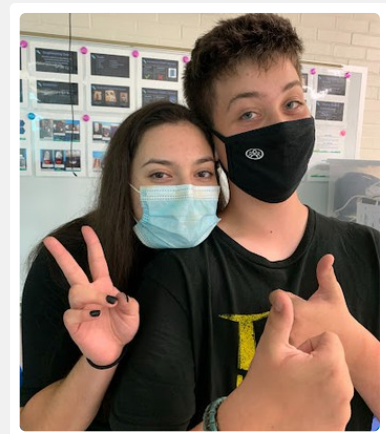
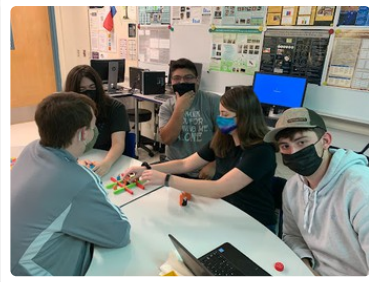
